## Lydia Venieri: War Games

**Stux Gallery** presents, on the occasion of the Scope Basel International Art Fair, new digital photograph-works on silk by Lydia Venieri.

Venieri explores the juxtaposition of hyper-realistic elements and seemingly naïve images of children's dolls. Inserting the main action narrative of the photograph inside the eerily sincere eyes of children's dolls. Venieri manages to disarm viewers at first glance, while delivering a potent punch of hysteria upon further inspection. The dolls volunteer themselves to our gaze, beckoning the viewer to approach in an unquarded and vulnerable state.

Images of suicide bombings in Israel and the devastation caused by the allied bombing of Nagasaki are literally pulled from the headlines. Captured inside the reflections of the haunting gaze of these empty vessels, they create a mysterious relationship between two conspicuously diverse visual worlds.

Continuing her search for the human embodiment of social issues within the constructs of a deceivingly simple children's play toy, Venieri's new photographic series offers an in-depth look at human perception and the dissemination of images and information.

Lydia Venieri was born in Athens, studied at the Ecole Nationale Superieure des Beaux Arts in Paris, and lives in New York City. Having won the Academie Francaise de Paris Medal for Sculpture, she has been featured in numerous solo and group at such venues as the George Pompidou Centre in Paris, The Athens 2004 Olympics, Centre for Contemporary Art in Dordrecht, National Gallery of Greece.
